IMPORTANT NOTICE

From Monday 20th October we are changing the way that pupils enter school in the mornings. Children will no longer be required to line up in the school playground.

Instead, the doors will be open at 8.45am and pupils will be able to enter their classrooms. There will be a member of staff at each entrance to meet them. Please note only children will be allowed into the school building. If you have a message for the teacher, please ensure that you write a note to be handed to the member of staff at the entrance to be passed on to the relevant class teacher.

- Reception, Years 1 & 2 and 3H are to enter via the KS1 doors of the Main Building.
- 3G and Year 4 are to enter via the Annex Hall doors.
- Years 5 & 6 are to enter through the Years 5 & 6 doors of the Annex Building.

We hope that this will be a calmer start to the school day, and will alleviate worries for parents who have children lining up in different places.

As usual the doors will be locked at 8.55am and any late children will need to enter school through the school office.

If you need to speak directly with your child's class teacher, please approach them at the end of the day or ideally during their fortnightly Parent Drop In session.

The Health Spot - Getting your 5 a day

Some tips from change4life to help you and your family get your 5 portions of fruit and vegetables a day:

- Shop for in-season fruits and vegetables (these should be cheaper from local farm shops and big supermarkets!)
- Canned fruit and veg will also contribute to your 5 a day, provided the fruit is preserved in it's own juices rather than sugar water, and will not go off as fast as fresh produce.
- Frozen vegetables will also last longer than fresh veg (so may be a better option
 if you do the weekly shop in bulk!) and can be healthier than fresh vegetables if
 they have been frozen immediately after harvesting.
- Carrot and celery sticks, as well as bags of grapes, bananas e.t.c make for healthy alternatives to chocolate and crisps.
- Remember, a handful = 1 portion!
