Late Packed Lunches

Packed lunches which are delivered to the school office after Morning Registration create complications during the school day for office staff and on occasion are not collected by their owners - who then spend the afternoon hungry.

It has been in place since 2nd February 2015 that any pupil who is not signed up for a school lunch or due to go home for lunch, and who has no packed lunch with them at Morning Registration, will be signed up for a school dinner which parents are expected to pay for.

Please do not approach the school office to accept a late packed lunch as they are not permitted to do so and this puts them in an unfair and tricky situation. Packed-lunches must be with children when they enter the school site from 8:45am.
