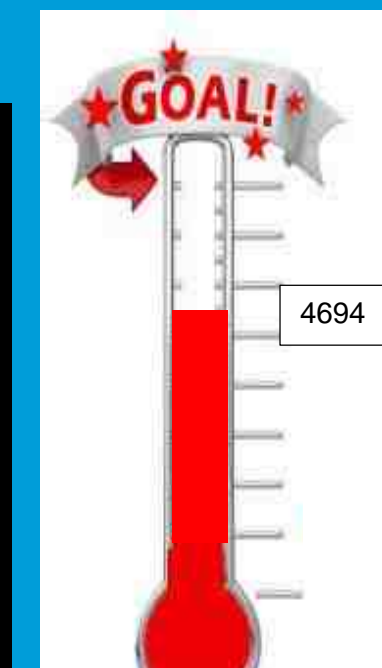

No payments can be made after that date.

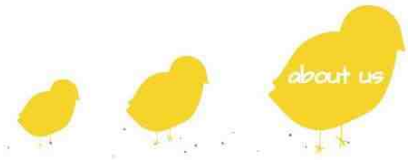


SCOOTERS OR BIKES ARE NOT TO BE RIDDEN ON THE SCHOOL PREMISES.

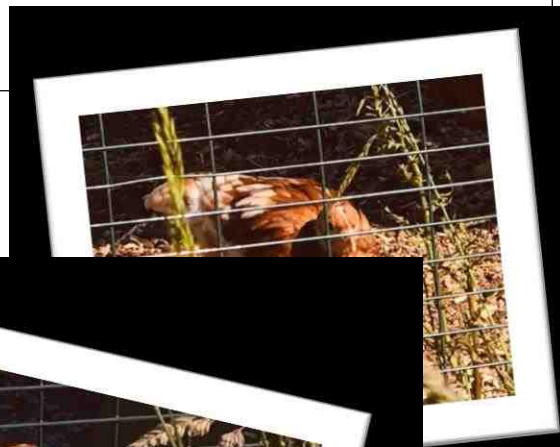

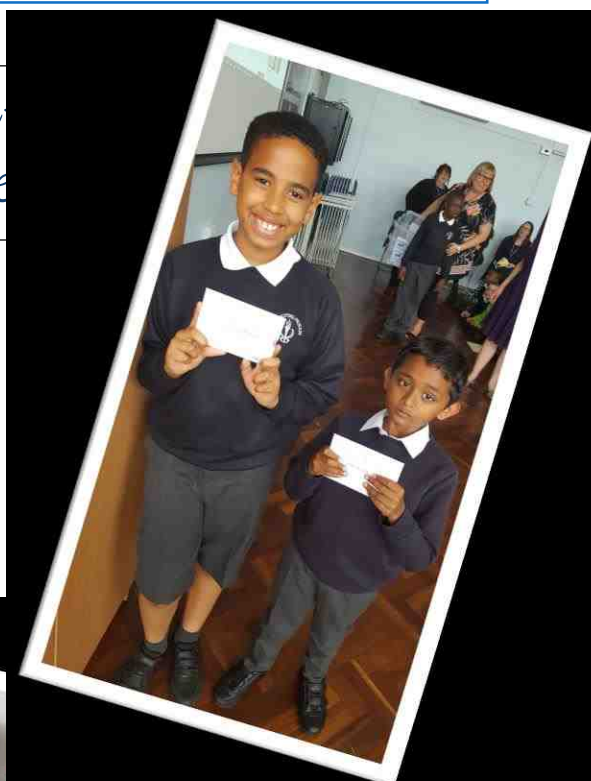

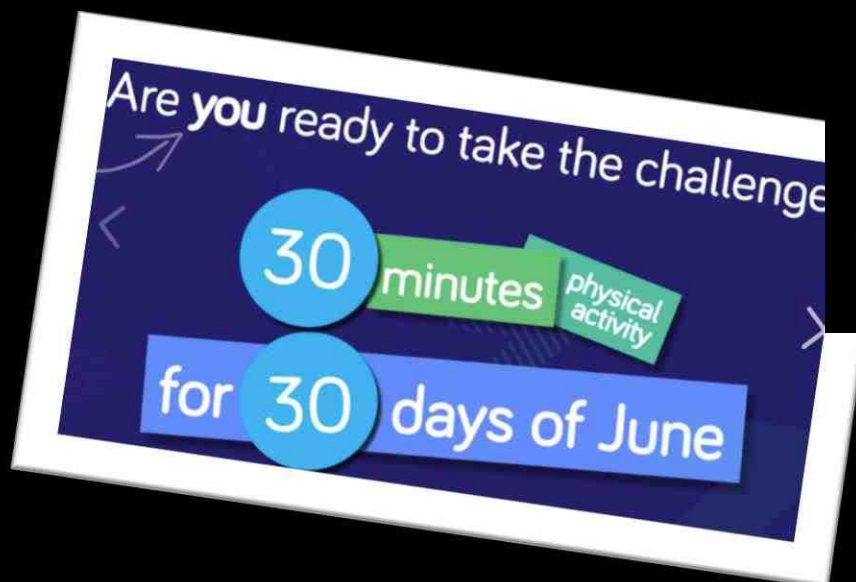

INVESTORS IN PUPILS

We have been contacted by Investors in Pupils, sending "their warmest congratulations to the School, the pupils, the Staff and whole school community for accrediting to the Investors in Pupils quality mark". We are the first school in Thurrock and Essex to achieve this.

The school has an abundance of talented, creative and enthusiastic pupils.

A parent shared "My son loves everything. There's an enormous focus on pupil responsibility and development throughout school and in all classes – they're all singing from the same song sheet".

The assessor felt this was "a particularly apt analogy given the amount of fantastic singing witnessed".

He wrote that our "pupils demonstrated an awareness of personal targets and an understanding of their own role in the target setting process".

He loved our Celebration assembly and stated it provided an "uplifting contribution to the school day that not only recognised pupil achievement (Head Teacher awards, Going for Gold bronze and silver certificates, salad bar monitor, Employee of the month, Mathletes, Pen licenses), but equally encouraged pupils to reflect on their achievements"
