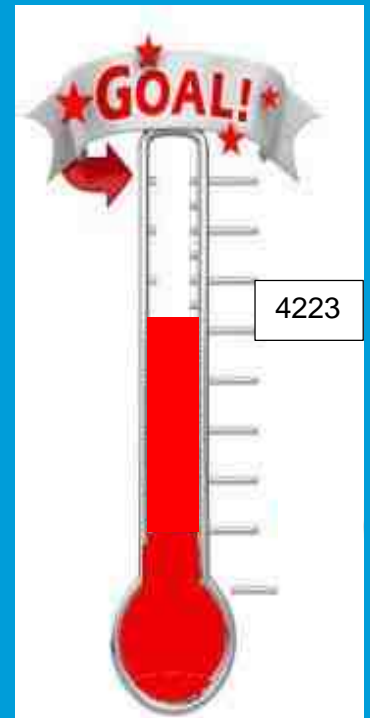

Last Thursday, an Investors in Pupils assessor visited our school. A group of our year 6 children carried out a learning walk with the assessor that lasted 45 minutes.

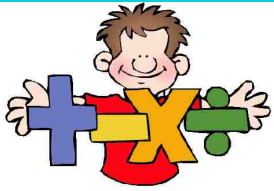
They guided him around the whole school and took him to every classroom. The assessor commented on how much they impressed him and how well they explained everything that we do at Kenningtons.
