

## No mobile phones

#### ZERO TOLERANCE - NO PUPIL MOBILE PHONES IN SCHOOL

From September 2019 no pupil will be allowed to bring a mobile phone / device to school. Items cannot be left at the office to be collected later, and cannot be put in bags/lockers.

Mobile phones will be removed if Staff become aware they are in school and Parents/Carers will be contacted about collecting the phone.

This rule has been in place for some time but it is now clear that Parents/Carers and/or pupils have chosen to allow phones to be on school premises.

We have dealt with several incidents this year connected to the misuse of mobile phones – incidents that would not have occurred if pupils did not have the mobile device on them.

The rule applies to any device that can be used to make calls, video, take photographs or post onto social media.

This rule is there to safeguard and protect our school community.



# **Sports 2018/2019**

A message from Mrs Harris:

Sport and PE have been a huge part of school life this year, and we have achieved so much.

Thank you to all Parents/Carers that have supported us by transporting pupils to events - your commitment has been greatly appreciated.

After several months of training for **Cross Country** Alice won the Y5 race and Taqiah came  $2^{nd}$  in Y3 race. Our Y6 girls' team came  $3^{rd}$  overall and our Y3 girls' team were the overall winners, sending them through to the Essex Final.

22 schools participated in **Sportshall Athletics** and our Y3 and Y4 teams both came 3<sup>rd</sup>, winning bronze medals.

Our Tag Rugby team came  $3^{rd}$  in their rally and our Dance Squad also came  $3^{rd}$  out of 14 schools in their dance competition.

Fantastic results from both our **Netball** and **Football** teams who both came 2<sup>nd</sup> in the leagues, winning silver medals. The Football team came 2<sup>nd</sup> having got through to the Cup Final. And at their end of season rally our Netballers got through to the semi-finals and came 3<sup>rd</sup>, winning bronze medals.

The **KS1 Squad** performed brilliantly and at Borough Olympics they were the overall track winners by over 140 points. They finished  $3^{rd}$  out of 39 schools. **Kenningtons Borough Olympics** team won the Second League last year coming  $3^{rd}$  out of 10 schools and are now in the highest league.

And to add to all this amazing news, we have seen such fantastic support from **Parents/Carers** this year with so many of you attending our 30:30 family events; there were over 50 families at the Family Park Run alone.

Next year we plan on turning the bronzes into silver or gold. We can do this!
