APPLYING FOR A PRIMARY SCHOOL PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER 2017

If your child was born between **1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013**, you must apply for a primary school place for **September 2017**.

Apply online from 1 November at: thurrock.gov.uk/admissions



Go to **thurrock.gov.uk/admissions** and follow the instructions on screen. There you will also be able to open an electronic copy of Thurrock Council's composite prospectus for Thurrock primary schools which you should read before completing an application.

To apply online you must have an e-mail account.

You should go along to one of the Council's briefings for parents before you complete an application.

Wednesday 19 October 2016 Civic Hall, Blackshots Lane, Grays, Essex RM16 2JU from 4.00pm - 5.30pm and 7.00pm - 8.30pm.

Offers will be available for online applicants from 12.30am on 18 April 2017 by logging into your account.

Complete the application, listing up to four schools that you wish to apply for, in your order of preference, including amongst them any schools outside of Thurrock for which you wish to apply. Make sure that you also complete the supplementary forms that some schools require and return them directly to the school by the closing date for applications.

If you have more than one child transferring to primary school, it is essential that you fill in an application for each child needing a place. If you do not complete the application and return it by the closing date of **15 January 2017** you may be allocated a place at a school with space available, after all on-time applications have been dealt with.
