### E-Safety: Keeping Your Child Safe Online

**NSPCC** and **O2** have joined forces to provide parents with the skills and support to keep their child safe online. They have released a list of their top 7 tips (below)

1. Have the conversation early and often
2. Explore online together
3. Know who your child is talking to online
4. Set rules and agree boundaries
5. Make sure that content is age-appropriate
6. Use parental controls to filter, restrict, monitor or report content
7. Check they know how to use privacy settings and reporting tools
