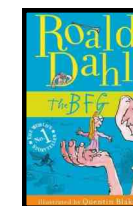
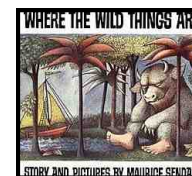
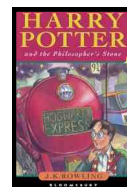

Alert: Ventolin Accuhaler 200mcg (Salbutamol Sulfate)

Level: Class 2 – Patient Level recall – Action by 26/02/2018

Patient Level recall

Glaxo Wellcome UK Limited is recalling the below Lots of Ventolin Accuhaler 200mcg because a manufacturing issue with these Lots has been identified which has resulted in a small number of units not delivering the full number of doses.

Ventolin Accuhaler 200mcg (Salbutamol Sulfate)

Action for: Pharmacists and technicians:

1. Check all stock, dispensed items and patients own medicines
2. Quarantine any batches found
3. Record all checks and action taken within the "ward pharmacy communication book"
4. Update file on SharePoint with "action taken on ward" or record "no affected batches found".

Action for: Inpatient ward managers:

1. Check the ward pharmacy communication book to confirm if pharmacist/technician has acted on this alert, especially if the ward is not visited daily by a Pharmacist
2. If not, follow above steps 1-3 and inform Pharmacy as soon as possible
3. Send response to your Assistant Director/CAS nominated lead in line with your local protocol with either: "Actioned by ward nurses" or "actioned by pharmacist on ward".

Action for: Clinics and Community Staff

Should health professionals come across patients using these inhalers, please check if the inhaler is from an affected batch. If patient is using an affected batch, please inform the patient to contact their GP for a new supply. If NELFT have supplied the affected inhaler, please email Pharmacy or call ext.64383 for replacement supply.
