Artists come together for NEW: DEFENCE exhibition at Coalhouse Fort, Essex





In the year that marks the centenary of the end of the First World War, a pop-up art exhibition at Coalhouse Fort near Thurrock takes a fresh look at the theme of 'defence'.

Made possible with the support of Heritage Lottery Fund and Arts Council England, the exhibition takes the 144-year-old fort and its location overlooking the River Thames, as its starting point. Caught between a military past and its current use as a tourist attraction and cultural space, the fort and its identity are gradually changing. On the one hand Coalhouse Fort is falling apart, it is redundant, being reclaimed by nature, and is vulnerable and fragile - the very antithesis to its original purpose. But at the same time a team of dedicated volunteers is working with the local council to save and preserve it.

Making use of the fort's dungeon-like magazines in the bowels of the building, dark and ghostly corridors, and casemates where guns would have stood, as well as the fort's dedicated gallery space, the exhibition takes visitors on a journey through an extraordinary historical site, inviting audiences to consider how we engage with these kinds of spaces, and what their future purpose might be.
