Medical Tracker Notifications

Our new system of recording and reporting first aid incidents means that parents will now receive an email notification from Medical Tracker to notify them of their child's injury, rather than a paper form being sent home with pupils at the end of the day. The emails are replacing the old system of paper forms and should not be cause for alarm.

For serious injuries (e.g. head injuries) or if the office need to talk to parents for any other reason, phone calls to parents will continue to be made as per the usual system of incident reporting. Please make sure your contact details are up to date to ensure the office can reach you when needed. It may be advisable to provide a work number in addition to home and mobile, or perhaps to add a trusted relative or family friend to your child's record as an emergency contact to ensure that someone is always available in the rare case of emergency.

The Battle of the Elements! - Friday 13th July 2018

Please keep the afternoon of Friday 13th July 2018 free as we will be inviting families onto the school site to watch pupils perform in the Battle of the Elements! This half-term pupils are working on creating dance performances based around different elements and natural phenomena (like tornados and rain storms).
