Trainers and Plimsolls for After-School Clubs

Some pupils have recently tried to wear unsuitable footwear to their after-school club sessions. We would like to remind parents and pupils that for after-school clubs that require physical activity (e.g. athletics) pupils must wear plimsolls or trainers. Please note that coaches may refuse to let pupils participate in after-school clubs if they do not have appropriate kit with them and refunds are not made under these circumstances. It is important pupils have the correct kit to prevent injury and to allow them to enjoy their after-school club sessions.

The Health Spot - Staying Hydrated (and reducing single-use plastics!)

In addition to enjoying water with their school dinners or packed lunches, we encourage pupils to drink water throughout the school day to stay hydrated. All pupils are invited to bring a water bottle with them to school to drink from throughout the day. Our pupil Eco Warriors recently conducted a survey of plastic use in the school and found that over 80 single use plastic bottles are disposed of a day at Kennintons. Waste plastic takes a long time to break down in the environment, and especially pollutes rivers and seas. We would like to encourage pupils to use re-usable plastic bottles.
