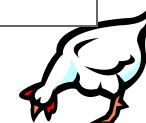
Jeans for Genes Day Friday 20th September

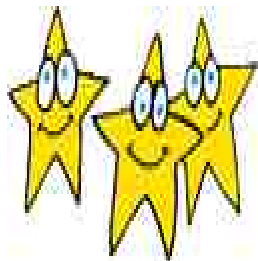
Tissues

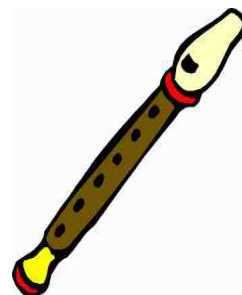
