Football Match

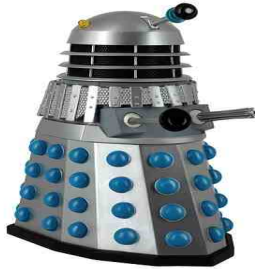
Kenningtons played their first league match on Tuesday
