This is for health and safety reasons and to enable staff to move around the site efficiently while setting up their classrooms in the morning. This will also avoid distractions for pupils trying to finish their lessons before afternoon pick-up at 3:15pm.

The Health Spot: National Childhood Measurement Programme (NCMP)

Public Health England have written to thank us for participating in the National Child Measurement Programme. In the graphic to the right you can see how we compare as a school to the average for Thurrock Local Authority schools.

Obesity is a leading concern for children's health and wellbeing. Nationally 9.1% of Reception children and 19.1% of Year 6 children are obese. Evidence demonstrates that maintaining a healthy weight is important not only for a child's physical, social and mental wellbeing but also for their capacity to do well at school.

As a school we will continue to work hard to promote health and wellbeing for our pupils.
