### Friday 27th May



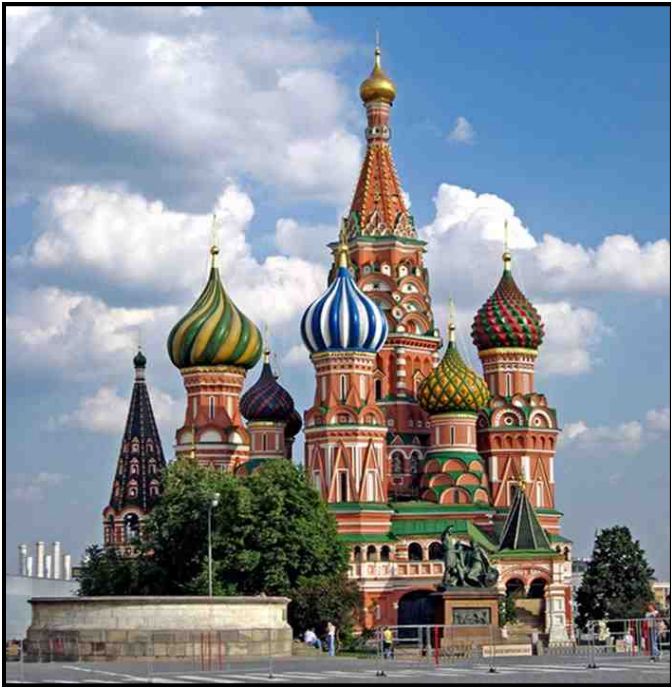

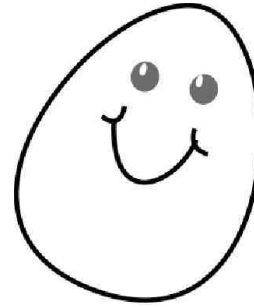
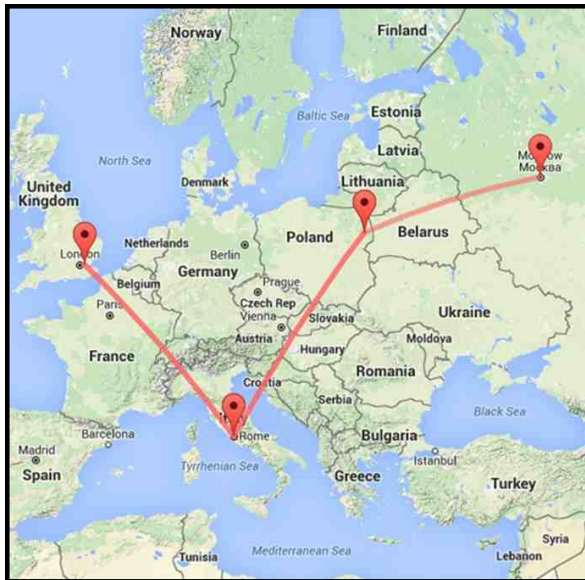




### Walk the World - Where have we got to this week?
