Outstanding Debts

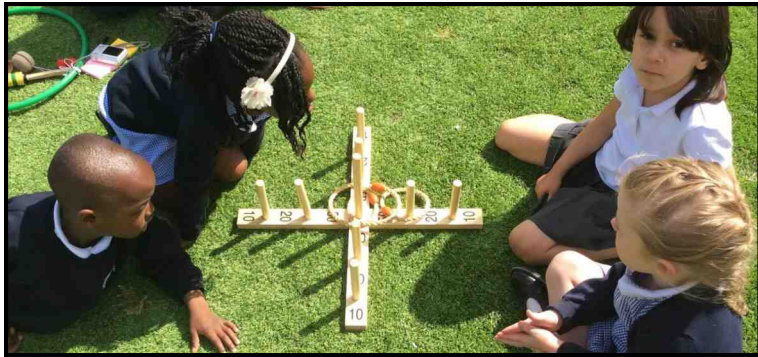
