### Saturday 18th January - Free Animal Fun Day

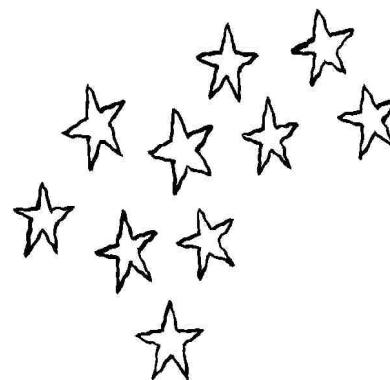
To celebrate the opening of "A Ladybird Childhood" Maidstone Museum & Bentlif Art Gallery are hosting a free animal fun day at the museum on
