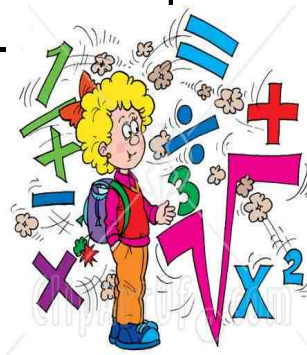

Important Information re School Dinner Debts

On Friday the 14th February 2014 our current contract with Thurrock and Havering Catering Service comes to an end. Subsequently anyone with outstanding debts will need to clear them before being able to order school dinners with Chartwells. A packed lunch should be provided for your child until debts are paid in full. A phone call home will be made if your child is not sent to school with a lunch. It is the parents responsibility to ensure that this happens.

Any outstanding debts must be paid in full by Tuesday 25th February 2014. Failing this we will claim the outstanding amount plus a fee of £25.00 plus annual interest of 8% via HM Courts and Tribunal Service Money Claim Online.
