The Health Spot: Water

As of January 2016 packed lunch children will only be permitted to drink water provided by the school as is the case with children who have school dinners. Please do not send your children in to school with drinks in their lunchbox when we come back in the New Year.

This initiative is being introduced because we want Kenningtons children to be healthy and to develop good habits. This is part of our continuing commitment to improving pupil health.

In our newsletter on 9th January 2015 we reported that to help in improving and maintaining the health of pupils a series of regulations had been made mandatory for local authority schools, new free schools and schools that convert to academy status. The regulations <u>included an emphasis</u> on making water the drink of choice.

As an academy founded between 2010-2014, Kenningtons Primary is not obliged to follow these regulations. However at Kenningtons we believe it is important to promote the drinking of water during the lunch-break and

If your child is absent from school due to a pre-booked medical appointment, or an appointment due to illness, please ensure you inform the school in advance <u>and bring the medical evidence to the office so it</u> can be copied for your child's file.

- Medical evidence (such as an appointment card from the doctor/dentist/hospital) is required in advance.
- If it is necessary for your child to be out of school for this reason, they should be returned to school directly after the appointment.




