The Health Spot - Staying Active

Last week we talked about walking, but there are many other ways to stay active this winter for those who would rather be indoors:

Dancing - Whether in class or in front of the TV, dancing is a great way to get the energy (and the giggles) up for the festive season. Check notice boards at local halls for details of available classes. You can also search Youtube for easy to follow tutorial videos to try at home - especially when it comes to some of the dancing styles on Strictly Come Dancing!

Swimming - The Chafford Sports Complex (RM13 9DX) holds public swimming sessions most weekday evenings and morning sessions at the weekend. The pool at Hornchurch Sports Centre (RM11 1JU) is open to the public early afternoon and evenings. Impulse Leisure in Belhus (RM16 2JU) also run family swimming sessions. Vouchers for free swimming sessions are often available through the local council or cereal pack promotions.

Bowling - Ten pin bowling is a great family activity, with lighter bowling balls (and bowling aids for the really tiny!) enabling children to take part as well. Namco Funscape Romford (RM1 1AU) and Namco Funscape Dagenham (RM9 6XW) provide a wonderful bowling experience - including some arcade style gaming areas. Alternatively, ten empty plastic bottles, a long hallway and a foam ball can provide equal amusement!
