The Health Spot - Watching the salt

To stay healthy, our goal should be to eat no more than 6g of salt a day for adults– that's around a teaspoonful, which isn't very much at all. We need to watch the salt – both how much we add to food and how much is in the foods that we buy.

It's not just adults that need to watch the salt – we need to keep an eye on salt intake for children too. Children under age 11 should be eating less salt than you – that's even less than one teaspoon!

Recommended maximum amounts of salt for children from Change4Life:

- Kids aged one to three: 2g salt a day (0.8g sodium)
- Kids aged four to six: 3g salt a day (1.2g sodium)
- Kids aged seven to 10: 5g salt a day (2g sodium)
- Kids aged 11 and over: 6g salt a day (2.4g sodium)
