#### A Note from the Headteacher:

This week I have been sent some information from Public Health England regarding the National Child Measurement programme. In this programme children in reception and Year 6 have their height and weight measured. This data is collected for every child in England. The results for our school show that we are in line with national averages - however it is shocking reading. In reception 25% of children are overweight or obese. This increases to 34% of children in year 6. This data is an average of the last 3 years.

We have many strategies in school to support children to make healthy lifestyle choices but it doesn't seem to be working! Initiaitves like 'Walk the World' and the family fitness programme should be making a difference.

We really need you to help your children. So what could you do?? In very simplistic terms it's about eat less (calories) and do more (exercise). You could decide to swap items in your child's packed lunch for healthier options or perhaps park further away from school to make the walk a bit longer.

If you have any ideas of additional things we could do in school please let us know. It would be great to see next year if the data show that we are making improvements.

We would like to thank Year 6 parents for completing feedback slips to let us know their views on what went well at the Year 6 Interhouse and what changes they would like to see in the future.

In terms of suggesting ways to improve the event, parents have suggested potential changes such as amending the seating arrangements, changing the team organisation, adding "extra games" and to "get the adults involved" in future Interhouse events. If your child was born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015, you must apply for a primary school place for September 2019.

## Apply online from 1 November at: thurrock.gov.uk/admissions



Go to **thurrock.gov.uk/admissions** and follow the instructions on screen. There you will also be able to open an electronic copy of Thurrock Council's composite prospectus for Thurrock primary schools which you should read before completing an application.

To apply online you must have an e-mail account.

You should go along to one of the Council's briefings for parents before you complete an application.

First session begins at 4.00pm - 5.30pm and the second session begins at 7.00pm - 8.30pm.

Complete the application, listing up to four schools that you wish to apply for, in your order of preference, including amongst them any schools outside of Thurrock for which you wish to apply. Make sure that you also complete the supplementary forms that some schools require and return them directly to the school by the closing date for applications.

If you have more than one child transferring to primary school, it is essential that you fill in an application for each child needing a place.



If you do not complete the application and return it by the closing date of 15 January 2019 you may be allocated a place at a school with space available, after all on-time applications have been dealt with.
