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PE Kit and Athletics Kit

We will be speaking to pupils in school about the below and would appreciate it if parents could reinforce the message at home:





- A lot of PE kits are going home after after-school clubs and are not being sent back in. Pupils should change out of their PE kit at the end of after-school club and leave it in school so it is ready for school PE lessons.
- We have had a rise in pupils stating they do not have their PE kit in school in order to avoid PE lessons. It later transpires that they have kit in their lockers. Teachers have been instructed to check lockers to stop this practice and issue detentions to pupils who do this.

A reminder that all pupils are expected to have their PE Kit in school for PE Lessons and participation in after school activities. **Physical Education kit is as follows:** Black slip-on plimsolls, navy blue shorts or black shorts; plain white T-shirt. Jogging bottoms and sweatshirts may be worn when the weather is cold.
