Quorum

The quorum of the Committee will be 3 members.

Pupil & Curriculum

1. To review, monitor and evaluate the curriculum so that it is balanced, broadly based and:
 - Promotes the pupils' spiritual, moral, cultural and mental and physical development.
 - Prepares pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.
2. To monitor and evaluate the impact of quality of teaching on rates of pupil progress and standards of achievement.
3. To ensure that the requirements of children with Special Educational Needs or Disability (SEND) are met as laid out in the Code of Practice.
4. To monitor and evaluate rates of progress and standards of achievement by all pupils including those with SEND, Looked after Children and those pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium.
5. To develop and review policies.
6. To ensure the Academy has appropriate arrangements in place for safeguarding and child protection and that all statutory and local requirements are met.
7. To ensure that there are systems in place which enable all pupils to have equal access to the curriculum and the opportunity for pupils to make progress and that they are not unlawfully discriminated against on the grounds of sex, race, religion or disability as required under the Equalities Act 2010.
8. To monitor attendance and lateness and their impact upon pupil achievement.
9. To monitor and evaluate the impact of the funding received in respect of Pupil Premium and the PE and Sports Premium and approve annual reports on how these fundings were spent and their effect on pupils.

Admissions

1. To act in accordance with the Education [School Government] Regulations and other legislation affecting the conduct and responsibilities of School Governing Bodies.
2. To take any decisions required under the Governing Body's Admissions Policy and the Local Authority's Co-ordinated Admission Arrangements.
3. To consider and make changes where necessary to the Academy's Admissions and Nursery Admissions Policies.
4. To make recommendations as to the Academy's preferred admission area.
5. To advise the Governing Body of decisions taken within the powers delegated by submitting at the Full Governing Body Meetings, Minutes of PAC Committee Meetings.

Frequency - Twice a school year.
