As expected the Free School Meal Voucher Code scheme is starting to wind down. We have had confirmation that there will be **no voucher codes issued for the May Half Term**, but there will be a one off voucher code of £60 per child to cover eligible children for the summer holidays. As far as we are aware there will be no voucher codes issued next academic year, but if that changes we will of course let you know.

Family Hubs



Our Family Hubs are welcoming places for families with children aged 0 to 18, or 25 if they have a disability, to access information and support.

Services will include:

- Support for expectant and new parents (called our Start for Life offer)
- Midwifery and antenatal clinics
- Health visitor clinics
- Baby and child play sessions
- Parenting support
- Mental health support for children and parents
- Help with infant feeding
- Children's speech, language and early learning
- Support for children with special educational needs (SEND)
- Help with managing your child's behaviour
- Domestic abuse support
- Job, debt and welfare advice
- Drug and alcohol support
- Support for separating couples
