Jeans for Jeans day took place in school last week. We collected £366 which will be donated to Great Ormond Street Hospital to support the great work that they do to help poorly children and their families.

Trips and experiences continue to go ahead. Year 2 had an African Art day to support their learning in geography and art. The day was very enjoyable and the outcomes produced by the children were of a high quality.

We have introduced a non-curriculum skill for each year group this year. These have a 'life-skill' aspect and will enhance our curriculum offer to pupils. This week in school Year 5 took part in first aid training. The learnt how to resuscitate by practicing on dummies. All year 2 staff had training in Makaton so that they can teach this to the year 2 pupils. Being able to communicate with non-verbal children and adults enhances school life for all of our children. I look forward to sharing skills that other year groups are learning with you as the year progresses.

At Kenningtons we are quite famous for the pupil responsibility aspect of school life. Lots of other schools visit us to see what we do and how we do it. It's hard to remember a time when pupils didn't have jobs and responsibilities around the school and the contribution that they make to school life is outstanding. This aspect of school life reflects two of our core values; **experiencing success** and **demonstrating respect for one another, our environment and ourselves**'. It also is a great example of one of the 5 ways of well being, **Giving**. The charity, Mind report that 'Individuals who report a greater interest in helping others are more likely to rate themselves as happy.'

Thank you to those of you who have donated towards our harvest collection. The foodbank is always grateful for the donations we collect, and I can only imagine how thankful those who use the foodbank are as well.

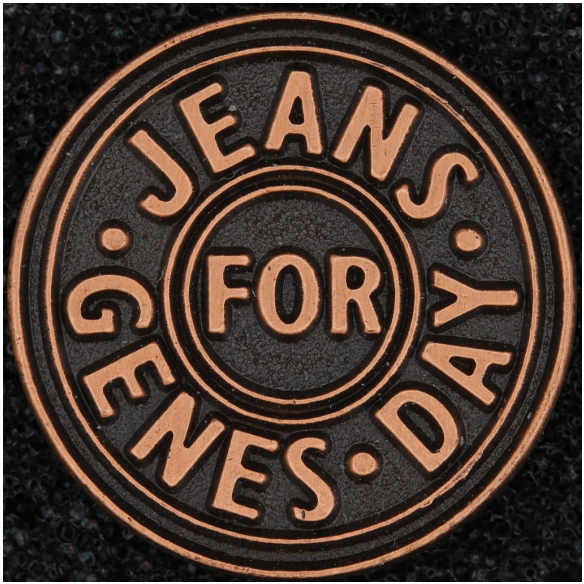

The Maths Coaches will help younger children practise their times tables on Times Table Rock Stars at lunchtime.



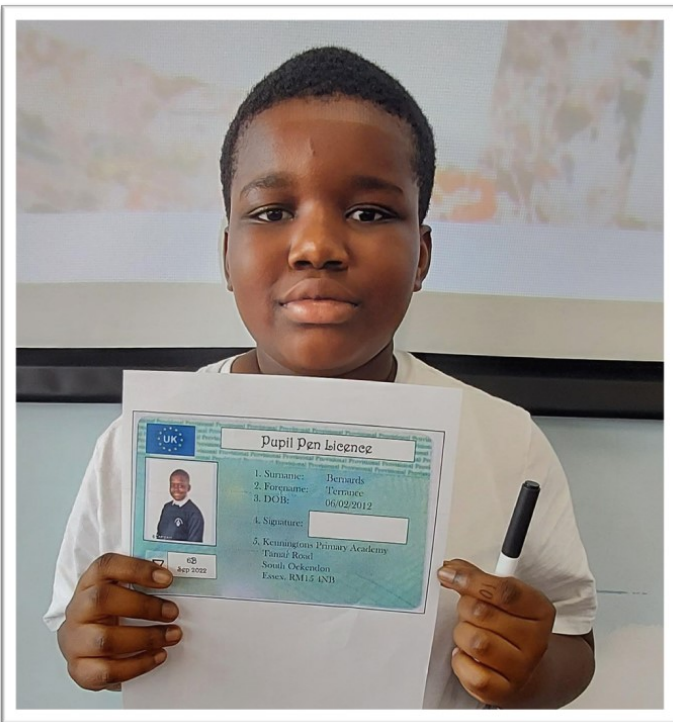


Health & Safety

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Thurrock Council primary school admissions

Important information – applying for a primary school place for September 2023

If your child was born between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019 you must apply for a primary school place for September 2023.

Apply online from 1 November at thurrock.gov.uk/admissions

Go to thurrock.gov.uk/admissions and select 'Primary school admissions'. You will be able to open an online copy of our prospectus for Thurrock primary schools, booklet called **Primary Admission Information September 2023**, which you should read carefully before applying.

You must have an email account to apply online.

You should also try to join us online at one of the briefing sessions before you complete an application.

Three briefing sessions for parents will be held on Thursday 27 October 2022 via webinar on the council website.

- First Session: 1pm - 2pm
- Second session: 4pm - 5pm
- Third session: 6:30pm - 7:30pm

Go to thurrock.gov.uk/admissions and select 'Primary school admissions' to access the webinar.

Offers will be available for applicants via your online account from 12:30am on 17 April 2023.

Apply for a primary school place

When making an application you can list up to four schools that you wish to apply for, in your order of preference. You can list schools outside of Thurrock, if you wish.

If you are applying to any school that is religious by character, make sure you also complete their supplementary form and return it direct to the school by the closing date for applications.

If you have more than one child transferring to primary school, you must apply separately for each child needing a place.

If you do not complete the application and return it by the closing date of **15 January 2023**, you may be given a place at the nearest school with a space available, after all on-time applications have been dealt with.
