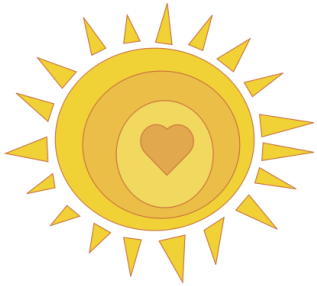

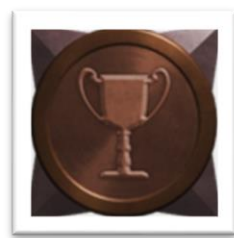
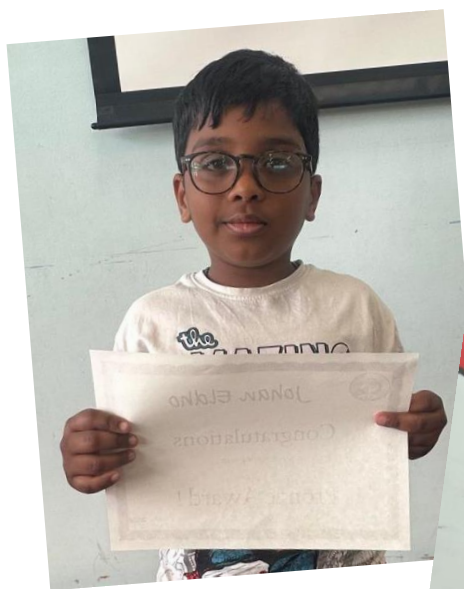
Employees of the Week

Tiara – Eco Warrior

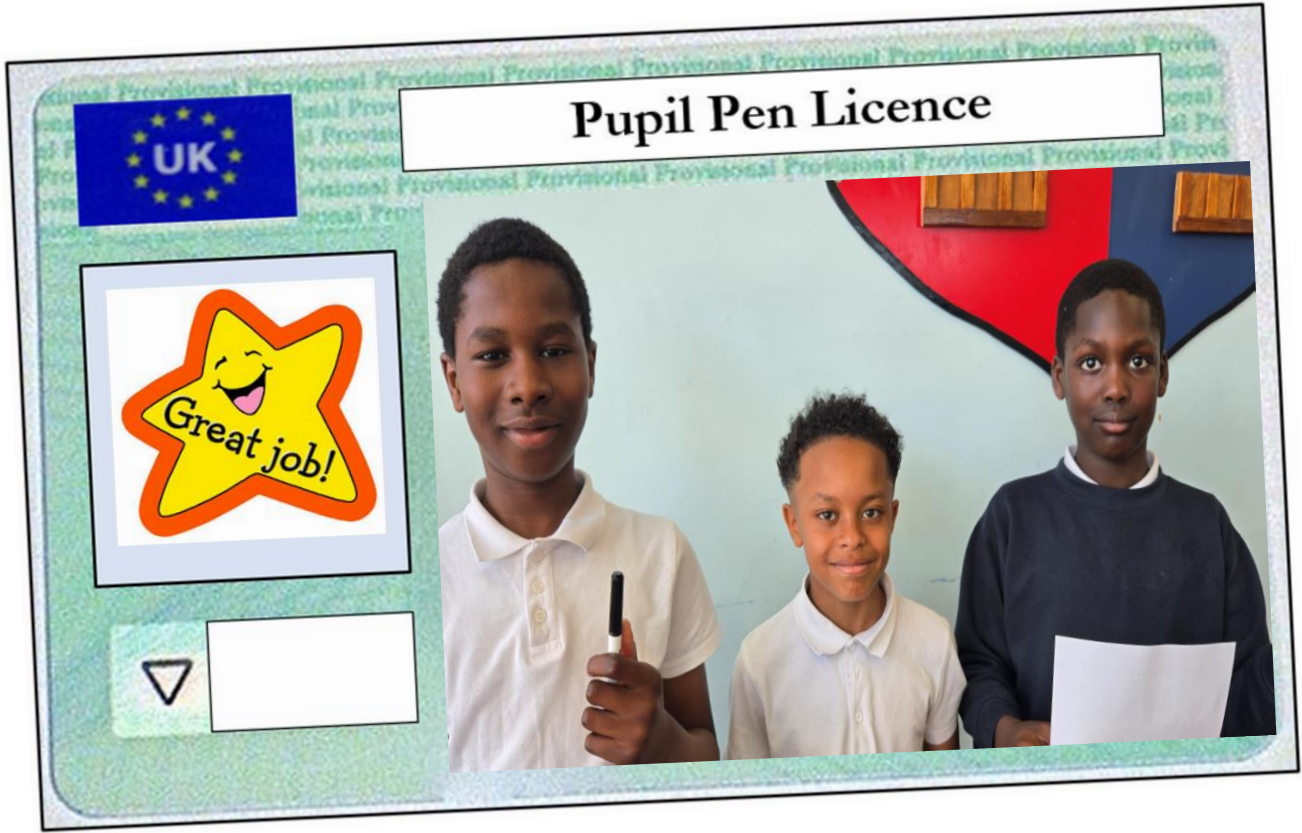
