Literacy



In Literacy this half-term, we will be sharing these books together:

Jack and the Beanstalk Jasper's Beanstalk Sam Plants a Sunflower The Enormous Turnip The Easter Story

For phonics we use 'Monster Phonics' Phase 1.

The programme develops speaking and listening skills. Children learn to become attuned to the sounds and begin to develop oral blending and segmenting skills. This teaching lays the foundations for teaching of systematic synthetic phonics.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child at home:

- Share books together
- Support your child with recognising their name and other familiar logos/signs.

- -Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'.




Easter Bonnet Parade – This will take place during the week commencing 25th March
