Learning Overview for Year One

Welcome to Year One!

English



This week we will begin by writing labels, lists and captions. We will be building on what the children have learnt in Reception. For example, using their phonic knowledge to segment to spell words and to use the sentence rules when writing captions and sentences.



Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:

Please listen to your child read at home and record this in their reading record.

Please check your child's understanding of what they have read by asking them questions and encouraging them to predict what might happen next.

When helping your child to write please encourage them to say their sentence aloud before writing and to use their phonic knowledge.

Maths



This week we will learning how to read, write and count numbers to 10. Children by the end of Year One need to be able to count to 100 and to write in words numbers 1 to 20.



Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths:

Try to help your child use maths in a real life situation as this embeds their knowledge and makes maths more purposeful. For example, What is that door number? What numbers are on this car registration plate? How many toy cars do you have?

Practise a few each day.

Look at the word, cover the word, write the word.
