Learning Overview for Year One

Week Commencing: Monday 18th September 2023

English



Next week, we are starting Handa's Hen. The children will be learning the story by sequencing the story. They will then begin to describe the animals by using adjectives before writing simple sentences.



Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:

Please listen to your child read at home and record this in their reading record.

Please check your child's understanding of what they have read by asking them questions and encouraging them to predict what might happen next.

When helping your child to write please encourage them to say their sentence aloud before writing and to use their phonic knowledge.

Maths



This week we will be continuing with place value within 10. The focus of the week will be counting forwards and backwards from any number up to 10. The children will also learn to identify and represent numbers using the language of equal to, more and less than.



Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths:

Try to help your child use maths in a real life situation as this embeds their knowledge and makes maths more purposeful. For example, What is that door number? What numbers are on this car registration plate? How many toy cars do you have?
