In English this half-term, we continuing our author study. Our chosen author is Julia Donaldson. We will be finding out about her and we will be exploring lots of her books. We will then produce our own writing outcomes. For example sing the book Tiddler we will be finding out information about sea creatures and creating our own sea creatures to write about.

We will then move on to our last traditional tale – The Three Little Pigs. We will be creating our own version of the story by changing the characters and the materials of the houses. We are certain that the children will have some fabulous ideas!

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English: Please encourage your child to practice writing simple sentences; forming letters correctly and using the correct punctuation and finger spaces. Punctuation for Year 1 is a full stop, a question mark and an exclamation mark. Please also encourage your child to re-read what they have written to check it makes sense.

Science



This term we will finish our learning about plants and then we will be learning more about materials. These lessons will be very practical and will include investigations about:

- Floating and sinking
- Waterproof / not waterproof materials
- Which materials are attracted to a magnet
- Comparing the properties of a range of materials

We will also finish our Seasonal Changes lessons by looking at the weather and the changes it brings as we move into the summer months.

Maths



In maths this half-term, the children will be learning about fractions. We will use the words halves and quarters when working with shapes and amounts.

We will then learn about place value using numbers to 100. We will be finding one more and one less than a given number, sequencing numbers and recognising tens and ones in numbers to 100.

Later in the term we will be learning about position and direction, time (o'clock and half past) and also money where we will be recognising notes and coins.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's maths: Please use lots of practical resources and real life examples of maths at home to cement your child's understanding. By the end of Year One the children need to be able to count to 100 and back and to write these numbers as digits. They need to be able to write in words numbers 1-20.

Topic



Our History and Geography topic for this half term continues to be All Around the World. We will be 'visiting' all of the continents and focussing on particular countries within them. We will be looking at features of countries and we will be using maps and globes to help us to locate them. We are having a focus study of the continent Australia where we will find out about daily life in different areas. We will look at the explorer James Cook who discovered this county.

We will also learn about the astronaut Neil Armstrong and why he is significant to the exploration of space.
