English



Maths



In Maths this half-term, the children will be learning about place value and addition. They will use Dienes to partition numbers and to reinforce their understanding of place value. They will use column method to add tens.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths: Check understanding of '+' and '=' symbol. Discuss greater than and Less than symbols

Topic



This half-term is we will be starting our Geography learning about 'A is for Africa'. We learn the continents, Oceans, identifying countries within these. They will discuss features of the countries using geographical language. Art – The seven core elements of art.
