Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English: Read at least 4 times a week, practise spellings, notice speech marks and discuss in your daily reading.


Maths



This week we will be continuing learning about place value and recognizing three digit numbers. We will be looking at the 3x table in our starters. We will be focusing on finding 10 more or 10 less than numbers to 1000.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths: Use TTRS for times table practise, focus on the 3x table, spot three digit numbers in your day to day life and read these. Can you add or subtract 10?

Spellings



Suggestions of ways you can support your child's spellings: practise in a variety of ways daily, use a dictionary to find definitions and model using these words.

Extra Information:

Reading: 3HG will collect reading merits on a Friday. 3G will be collecting merits on a Thursday. Reading records are available to buy on the playground in the mornings.

Homework: Google Classroom is now up and running. Please log on and access the class.
