

## English



In English this half-term, the children will be writing persuasive leaflets. We will focus on precise adjectives, subordinate clauses (conjunctions), exaggerations, facts and opinions and alliteration.

By the end of the half term, the children will have created their own 'land' and written a leaflet persuading people to visit.

**Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:** Ask your child about grammar at school and how they would use this. Collect and read travel leaflets. They are free in many shops!

## Science



Our science topic for this half-term is light. The children will be very hands on to develop their scientific enquiry skills. We will be taking part in practical enquiries including a light workshop with an expert.

## Extra Information

Our topic for the rest of the summer term is Ancient Egypt. We will teach the children about where Egypt is located, the River Nile, society in Ancient Egypt. Children will develop their historical enquiry skills by using a range of sources to find out about the past.
