

English



In English this half-term, the children will use the text 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth' to inspire their writing. They will learn about the features of a set of instructions and including imperative verbs, time adverbials, adverbs of manner and conjunctions. They will write their own set of instructions for their boasting book.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English: Ask your child about grammar at school and how they would use this. Follow instructions together at home including recipes.

Science



Our science topic for this half-term is Rocks, Soils and Fossils. The children will be very hands on to develop their scientific enquiry skills. They will be grouping a range of rocks, learning about the rock cycle and finding out about how fossils are formed.

Extra Information
