

English



In English this half-term, the children will be writing persuasive leaflets. We will focus on precise adjectives, subordinate clauses (conjunctions), exaggerations, facts and opinions and alliteration.

By the end of the half term, the children will have created their own 'land' and written a leaflet persuading people to visit.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English: Ask your child about grammar at school and how they would use this. Collect and read travel leaflets. They are free in many shops!

Science



Our science topic for this half-term is light. The children will be very hands on to develop their scientific enquiry skills. We will be taking part in practical enquiries including a light workshop with an expert.

Extra Information

PE: Our PE days are Thursdays and Fridays. Please ensure children are wearing correct PE kit and no jewellery on these days (earrings can be taped up at home if needed).

Trips and Experiences

Maths



In Maths this half-term, we will be furthering our understanding of measures. Looking at time, mass, capacity, length, perimeter and money. This will consolidate the children's existing addition and subtraction skills. They continue to learn their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times table.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths: Allow your child to get involved with measuring food, telling the time, using money and reading food label measurements.

Topic



Our topic for the rest of the summer term is Ancient Egypt. We will teach the children about where Egypt is located, the importance of the River Nile, society in Ancient Egypt. Children will develop their historical enquiry skills by using a range of sources to find out about the past.
