## **English**



In English this half-term, the children will be studying myths and legends. They will look at a range of language features including fronted adverbials, conjunctions and expanded noun phrases. Finally, they will create their own myth and legend write this up for their Boasting Book.

#### Maths


#### **Extra Information**
