Maths



In Maths this half-term, the children will be looking at place value up to ten thousand. The children will explore this by using number lines, bar models and pictorial representations. They will learn how to use the formal column method to calculate and understand how to use the inverse operation to check their answer.

History



Our history for this half-term is Ancient Greece. The children will get to explore where Greece is and what it is like today. Understand the different time periods of Ancient Greece and what daily life was like for people living in Ancient Greece.
