Learning Overview for Year: 6

English



Continuing with our detective stories, this week the children will describe the setting, main detective character and rehearse using the conventions of speech punctuation to integrate into and develop a story. They will include fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and some figurative language to engage their reader.

In addition, we will be completing a baseline assessment for reading.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:

Please encourage your child to complete their homework each week and to read every day if possible, but at least 4 times each week. This will help their reading fluency and comprehension skills, as well as help to improve their writing.

Reading:

Two merit points will be awarded each week to a child who has read 4 times a week and documented this in their reading record/planner. This year, Year 6 children CAN record what they have read without an adult's signature although they will need to state what pages were read and what happened within these pages. Prior to the records being purchased, please record any reading on paper and send in to school.

Homework:

From the start of year 6 until the SATs in May, Year 6 will receive both English and maths homework each week. English will be linked to writing or grammar and will be a short task. For maths, your child will be sent home with a daily 'Quick 5' given out Tuesday – Friday (which should total 20 minutes across the week). Please encourage your child complete both pieces of homework each for which they will earn 2 merits per week. After SATs they will not be expected to complete homework.
