Maths



In Maths this half-term, the children will be looking at place value up to ten million. The children will read, write, order, compare and round numbers. They will then look at negative numbers and use them in context, before recapping their addition and subtraction skills, including decimals.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths: Please encourage your child to complete their daily quick 5 and access Times Table Rock Stars if they need to practice.

Topic



Our topic for this half-term is WW1. The children will get to explore where and why WW1 occurred. They will study the origins of the war, what happened during it (including key events), and its consequences and legacy on the world we live in today. This will be through both history and geography.
