Parent Questionnaire Summary

Summer 2026



Thank you to all the parents and carers who took the time to complete our Summer 2026 Parent Questionnaire. We received 151 responses, providing valuable feedback that will help us celebrate our strengths and continue to improve.

What You Told Us

The results show an overwhelmingly positive picture of parents' views of the school.

- **94%** of parents agree or strongly agree that **their child is happy at Kenningtons.**
- **96%** agree or strongly agree that **their child feels safe at school.**
- **92%** agree or strongly agree that **the school ensures pupils are well behaved.**
- **95%** agree or strongly agree that **their child receives the support they need to learn well.**
- **92%** agree or strongly agree that **the school communicates effectively.**
- **90%** agree or strongly agree that **the school makes decisions with children's best interests at heart.**
- **91%** of parents who raised a concern felt it was dealt with appropriately.
- **91%** of parents said they **would recommend Kenningtons Primary Academy** to another family.

What Parents Value Most

Many parents commented positively on the caring ethos of the school, the dedication of staff and the opportunities provided for pupils.

Some comments included:

"My child loves coming to school every day and teaches me something new most days."

"The extra-curricular opportunities that the children are given are great."

"We are very proud to be part of this school and would like to thank all of the staff for their dedication to our children."

"As a parent, I am extremely grateful for the support I receive."

These comments reflect the school's commitment to providing a safe, ambitious and nurturing environment where children can thrive.

You Said... We Will...

Although the feedback was overwhelmingly positive, a small number of parents identified areas where they would like to see further improvements.

Communication

Some parents would welcome more regular communication from teachers and additional notice for events.

We will:

- Continue to review how and when information is shared through ParentMail.
- Provide as much advance notice as possible for school events.
- Continue to encourage effective communication between home and school.
- Ensure that Parentmail communications clearly state which class and year group they are referring to.

SEND

A small number of parents requested greater clarity around SEND provision and communication.

We will:

- Continue to work closely with families through regular SEND review meetings.
- Continue to ensure parents understand the provision their child receives and how progress is monitored.
- Continue to provide staff training to meet a wide range of pupils' needs.

Behaviour and Bullying

Whilst the vast majority of parents reported that their child has not experienced bullying, a small number raised concerns about how incidents are communicated.

We will:

- Continue to investigate all reported incidents thoroughly.
- Continue promoting our positive behaviour culture and respectful relationships across the school.
